The Applicant is a Minnesota public (charter) school formed under Minn. Stat. 124D.10 et seq. Attachment II-1-A is a copy of the Applicant's application for a charter containing a detailed explanation of its program; Attachment II-1-B is the Affidavit of Sponsorship executed by the Minneapolis Public School District (Special School District #1) (the "Sponsor"), the sponsor of the Applicant's charter school; Attachment II-1-C is a copy of the letter from the Minnesota Department of Children, Families and Learning approving the sponsorship of the Applicant's school; and attachment II-1-D is a copy of the contract between the Applicant and Sponsor pursuant to which the Applicant will operate the school.

Under Minnesota law, the Applicant is considered to be public school district and has been designated as District 4 (TBD). For that reason, the Applicant is considered a political subdivision of the State of Minnesota for the purposes of Schedule B to this Application.

In accord with Minnesota law, the Applicant's school is a public school open to all students on a first come, first served basis up to the capacity of the school. If more students wish to attend than capacity, then a lottery is held to identify those students who will in fact attend. The Applicant may not charge tuition for attending the school. While exempt from most rules and regulations of the State of Minnesota in respect of the educational program presented, the Applicant is required to abide by all health/safety rules, anti-discrimination rules, and rules affecting the civil rights of students and employees.

Under Minnesota law, the Applicant may not own real estate, but may occupy a facility as a tenant. It is anticipated that it will occupy a facility purchased and renovated by Friendship Building Company, a supporting organization to the Applicant which has filed an Application for Exemption which is associated with this Application.
