COVID-19 Protocol for Friendship Academy of the Arts Scholars

Effective – January 10, 2022

Follow the appropriate path to determine if a scholar should stay home, come to school or get tested for COVID-19.

More Common Symptoms: Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher); New cough or one that gets worse; Difficulty breathing; Loss of smell or taste. Less Common Symptoms: Sore Throat; Nausea; Vomiting; Diarrhea; Chills; Muscle Pain; Extreme Fatigue; Severe Headache; Abnormal Congestion, Stuffy or Runny Nose.


Regardless of Vaccination Status

This path is for scholars with **ONE** symptom from the "less common" list

Does the scholar experience this symptom often?

Does the scholar feel normal?

Other Friendship scholars living in the same household **DO NOT** need to stay home.



NO

A scholar who feels sick

should not be at school.

If the symptom worsens or others develop, you can <u>Request a FREE</u> <u>COVID-19 Rapid Test for at-home</u> <u>testing.</u>

Parents & scholars who agree to be tested at school will need to submit a Test to Stay Consent Form.

Regardless of Vaccination Status

This path is for a scholar who HAS NOT had a close contact event at school with someone testing positive for COVID-19 but have:

- ONE "more common" symptom
- TWO or more "less common" symptoms

The Scholar Can:

- Stay home from school;
 or
- Be picked up from school;
 or
- Test to Stay at school each day until symptoms are resolved.

Scholars **MUST** stay home until their symptoms are resolved

they haven't had a fever for 24 hours without taking medication

negative test results prove the symptoms are not attributed to COVID-19.



Scholars with negative results can be at school.



Other scholars living in the same household may also attend school, unless they develop symptoms.

Scholars will have to quarantine for at least 5 days if:

- They are **unvaccinated**, not wearing a well-fitted mask, and have a close contact event at school.
- They are unvaccinated and have a close contact event outside of school with someone testing positive for COVID-19.
- They develop **ANY** symptoms after a close contact event at school regardless of vaccination status.

Scholars living in the same household as someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 must stay home from school OR

<u>Test to Stay</u> until the positive case's isolation period has ended.

Scholars
with positive test
results must stay
home for at least
5 days!

Regardless of vaccination status or having symptoms, getting tested 5 days after a close contact event is encouraged -- Request a FREE COVID-19 Rapid Test for at-home testing.
