Dear Friendship Families,

I am reaching out to inform you of our plan to continue supporting the academic growth and development of our students while schools are closed throughout Minnesota. It is our number one priority to maintain the health and safety of our students and families, while simultaneously preventing as much learning loss as possible.

Beginning on Monday, March 23rd, all students will begin distance learning until further notice. Teachers will post instructional videos and assignments by 9 AM daily, with the expectation that students will complete all required work before midnight.

In order to provide a weekly touch point, all students will have a 15-minute check-in with their homeroom teacher two times a week at a dedicated time and a 15-minute check-in with an educational assistant two times a week. During this call, teachers and support staff will:

- Check-in with students about the work they have completed
- Go over specific questions and problems
- Give them words of encouragement to do their absolute best and read, read!

Your child's teacher will coordinate with you on the best time to call - so this call is also an opportunity for you as the parent to touch base with your child's teacher and ask any questions that might be on your mind.

It is our recommendation that you establish a set time for when and a designated area in which your child will complete their work so that they experience consistent routines and procedures for engaging in academic tasks.

Included in this packet is information and guidance regarding distance learning policies and plans, a suggested schedule, contact information for teachers and educational assistants, and a framework for both math and literacy instruction.

Using Google Classroom

<u>Google Classroom</u> will be the primary source of learning and instruction during distance learning. Here is a handy <u>Google Classroom Tutorial for Parents.</u>

How to Access Google Classroom for the First Time

1. Log into your child's school GMail account by going to mail.google.

2. Once you've logged in to their email, you will see an invitation to join our Google Classroom.

Accept the invitation. (Note: some students have already joined their classroom. In this case, skip to Step 3.)

3. The invitation should take you directly to Google Classroom.

How to Log on the Google Classroom

- 1. Click on the 3 x 3 grid in the top right-hand corner of the computer.
- 2. Select Classroom.

How to Complete Assignments

- Teachers will post daily work and instructional videos daily by 9 AM.
- In Google classroom, you will see several headings:
 - "Stream" will be a live feed of all the assignments and announcements.
 - "Classwork" will have all the assigned work.
- Assignments will show up on Google Classroom at 12:00AM.
- Directions for each assignment will be provided in the assignment itself or on the web resource the assignment links to.
- Assignments should be completed by 11:59 PM each day.
- There are three ways to submit assignments:
 - Submitted for a document or quiz



- Posted in a class discussion
- A picture/photograph taken, uploaded, and sent to the teacher via email

How to Contact A Teacher

- All students will have a 15-minute check-in with their homeroom teacher two times a week at a scheduled, dedicated time and a 15-minute check-in with an educational assistant two times a week.
- Additionally, teachers, educational assistants, and paraprofessionals will hold office hours during which they will be available via email, messaging on Class Dojo, or for video talks through Google Meets to answer questions, explain assignments, and provide guidance as necessary

Student food pick-up information during school closures due to COVID-19

Friendship Academy of the Arts is providing students with meals while schools are closed due to the COVID-19 virus. These meals are intended to replace the meals services that students normally receive during the school day. Meals will be available starting Monday March 23rd from 10-2pm. Both breakfast and lunch will be available and you will be able to take up to 5 days worth of food at one time.
